### **Service Project Ideas for Small Groups**

Here are project ideas that involve off-site prep, then drop-off at Ralph Reeder Food Shelf or Incarnation's Ralph Reeder Food Shelf bin:

- If "in season", pull together ingredients for special timely requests, like Thanksgiving Bags & Holiday Baking Bags
- Collect "special request items" during campaigns like March MN FoodShare or July "Tons of Love"
- Prepare Birthday Bags – collect cake mix & frosting, paper plates & napkins in decorative birthday bags
- Collect diapers & wipes for babies and toddlers
- Collect donations and assemble summer safety bags/essentials bags/snackpacks, etc. Contact Ralph Reeder and they will let you know what is needed.
